

Recreate the four example layouts using the provided files. Each layout should be flexible and responsive, with a desktop and mobile view.

Use the provided stylesheet as a guide for how to name your elements. Please note you will need some of the HTML5 layout elements mentioned in chapter 17 of our textbook.

For mathematical purposes, assume each element takes up a third, two-thirds, or all of the main container. You should use only percentages and ems in your CSS, no pixels. The only exception to this would be your media queries, which should use 600 pixels.
