

Create a polished responsive website on a subject of your choice. Remember that a responsive website should include a flexible layout and media queries that adjust your design as necessary. For the purposes of this assignment, your site's design should be optimized for all screen sizes.

Your website should also include at least one advanced component. This could be a JavaScript mobile menu, an audio or video element, information for search engine optimization, a tracking code for analytics, or some type of embeddable content. The component you choose should make sense given the content of your site and should be styled as necessary to fit your design.

Requirements

- At least one advanced component
- Flexible layout
- Designed for all screen sizes
- No pixels used except for media queries, calculations included as comments
- All sources cited
- Present for critique (5 points)

Grading

Components

This assignment is worth 50 points. You will be graded on the following components:

Content (10 x 2 = 20 points) –

- Clear purpose
- Ample relevant material
- Concise and well-written
- Logically organized

Design and Layout (10 x 2 = 20 points) –

- Compliments content
- Consistent look and feel
- Good use of typography and spacing
- Polished

Code and Technical Details (10 points) –

- Correct and complete
- Clear, consistent, and logically organized
- Appropriate file structure

Rubric

Components will be graded using the following rubric:

A (10/9.5 points) –

- High quality
- Very few issues
- Does something interesting or unique

B (9/8.5 points) –

- Good quality
- Some issues

C (8/7 points) –

- Uneven quality
- Several issues

D (6 points) –

- Low quality
- Many issues

F (0 points) –

- Unacceptable
